Herrick Hansen Continues Winning Tradition

The Cary Classic Benefit Golf Tournament at the Caribou Country Club has a history of exciting finishes. The 24th annual event stood up to that tradition on Sunday July 8th when the tournament championship was decided in a one-hole playoff between perennial winner, Herrick Hansen of Perth Andover, New Brunswick and long time tournament participant, Dana Worster of Bangor.

"This is just one great tournament", said Hansen who is a member of the Aroostook Valley Country Club. "The competition was great.....there are a lot of golf events where once the tournament is over everyone but the winners leave, but here the golfers stick around to celebrate with the winners. That is very special. There is a great feeling with the event and I just can't help but return every year."

Viola Kemp, who is also a multi year winner of the tournament, took the overall ladies Division One gross title. Kemp, a former middle school teacher in Caribou, now resides in Palmyra. Kemp completed her 72-holes with a gross score of 159. In accepting the ladies top prize, Kemp said that she has always had a special place in her heart for the Cary Classic.

"I have played in 23 out of 24 tournaments here," she said. "There is a special 'hometown' quality about this event. It is so well organized with the best prizes of any tournament I have played. It is just a delight being here and I plan on returning as long as the Cary Classic continues."

The men's playoff completed two full days of tournament play that featured nearly 100 golfers. The tournament is coordinated by the Jefferson Cary Foundation with proceeds benefiting Cary Medical Center. Time Warner Cable is the primary financial sponsor for the event. \$8,000 in prizes were presented to winners in four men's divisions and two ladies divisions.

Kris Doody, RN, CEO at Cary Medical Center, expressed the hospital's appreciation to everyone involved in the event and acknowledged the significance of the funds raised over the past three years.

"The Jefferson Cary Foundation has directed the Cary Classic over the past three years," said Doody, who participated in the two day event. "In that time we have raised close to \$40,000. These funds will be critical in our plans to develop a new mammography suite here at Cary.
