Hede Donation to Fund Stroke Rehab

In the 75-plus years of its operation, Cary Medical Center has cared for many patients. Over this period of time entire families have received their care at Cary. The Hede family of Stockholm is such a family. There were twelve children in the Hede family and all of them, at one time or another, received medical attention at Cary Medical Center.

After the death of one of the siblings in Alaska, contributions from his co-workers were sent to the Hede family. This was the impetus for the first of many charitable contributions made to the JCF by the Hede family. John and Rosemary Hede have made donations to the Foundation in memory of his parents, and six of his siblings. These generous contributions, recognized with leaves on the "Tree of Life," will go toward the development of a comprehensive neurological rehabilitation service to assist victims of stroke to recover from their illness.

The Hedes have expressed their satisfaction with the care they have received at Cary. "There is a certain comfort in coming to a hospital where you know the nurses and staff and they in turn know you," said John and Rosemary.

The JCF would like to recognize the Hedes for their generosity and support of our community hospital, keeping the tradition established by Dr. Jefferson Cary nearly 100 years ago alive.
