# How Do I Give?

The Jefferson Cary Foundation manages a number of funds that are used to finance health care projects.

## The Jefferson Cary Foundation

The Jefferson Cary Foundation is a nonprofit 501(c)3 organization founded in 1993. The foundation's namesake is Dr. Jefferson B. Cary whose charitable bequest founded the original Cary Memorial Hospital that is known today as Cary Medical Center. Jefferson Cary Foundation's mission is to encourage philanthropic giving and, through careful financial management and analysis, provide funding for health care related projects and equipment that benefit all those served by the hospital.

## Our Mission

We are a charitable foundation committed to reducing human suffering through health care excellence and dedicated to the physical and mental well-being of all those who are touched by its generosity.

Your support and generosity have helped make these three important projects possible at Cary Medical Center: The addition of our Women's Imaging Center, Pines Center for Women's & Children's Health, and Jefferson Cary Cancer Center at Cary Medical Center.



## Memorial Funds

These funds are donated in memory of a deceased friend or relative, or are given in honor of an individual or group. Memorial funds can be unrestricted, which means that they can be used in the area of greatest need, or they can be designated to a specific department or area in the hospital. The Jefferson Cary Foundation takes great pride and care in the responsibility afforded them to help these funds grow and allocate the income to appropriate areas.

## Endowment Fund

The Endowment Fund is a permanent fund managed by the foundation. The principal of this fund remains permanently intact. Interest only income, generated by the fund, may be used for purposes designated by the Foundation Board of Directors. Funds may be used to support the expansion of services, purchase new technology or support other projects at Cary Medical Center. The fund benefits greatly from the Annual Appeal, which reaches out to members of the hospital family and those who reside in communities served by the hospital. Many generous donations have helped the Endowment Fund grow steadily since it's inception in 2001.

## Capital Campaigns

The Jefferson Cary Foundation also plays a key role in capital campaigns, which are fundraisers for major hospital renovations. These campaigns include the construction of the Chan Center, the Oncology & Specialty Clinic, the Women's Imaging Center, and the Pines Center for Women's & Children's Health. These projects allow the hospital to more efficiently deliver health care to our patients.

## Tree of Life

Through the corporate generosity of Daigle Oil Company, the tree of life adorns a prominent spot in the hospital entrance. The Tree of Life provides a permanent record of the philanthropy of those individuals and groups who have contributed to the foundation. Donations or a series of donations exceeding \$1,000 are commemorated with an engraved leaf on the tree. These donations may be in the form of a memorial contribution, or annual appeal donation, or any monetary gift given to the foundation in excess of \$1,000.

## Planned Giving

All contributions to The Jefferson Cary Foundation are tax deductible. While most donations are in the form of cash, the foundation also welcomes estate gifts, gifts of property, trusts or real estate. The Jefferson Cary Foundation sponsors the Cary Classic Benefit Golf Tournament. This annual event, a highlight of the golf season in northern Maine, has generated substantial resources for projects at Cary Medical Center.
