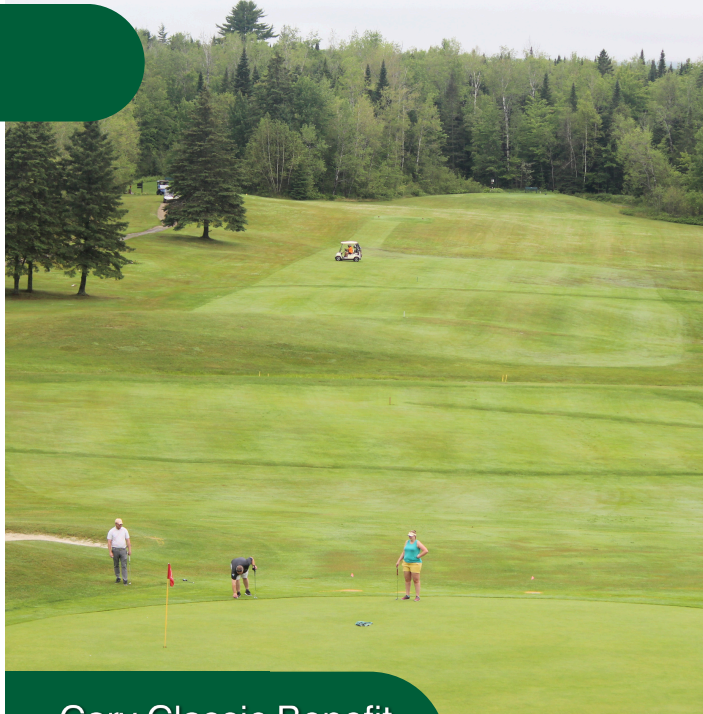

The Jefferson Cary Foundation is a nonprofit 501 (c)3 organization founded in 1993. The foundation's namesake is Dr. Jefferson B. Cary whose charitable bequest founded the original Cary Memorial Hospital that is known today as Cary Medical Center.

Our Mission

We are a charitable foundation committed to reducing human suffering through health care excellence and dedicated to the physical and mental well being of all those who are touched by its generosity.

Tree of Life

Through the generosity of Daigle Oil Company, the Tree of Life adorns a prominent spot in the hospital entrance.
